Mission Statement: The mission of Menonite Healthcare Fellowship (MHF) is to be an interdisciplinary community of Anabaptist health professionals which seeks to nurture the integration of faith and practice, to provide opportunities for dialogue on health related issues, and to address specific needs through education, advocacy, and service.

Background: MHF was formed in June 2011 when Menonite Medical Association and Menonite Nurses Association joined to form a new organization open to all Anabaptist healthcare professionals.

Membership Eligibility: Healthcare professionals from the full spectrum of training and academia, health care services, and ministry are welcome to join. **Members shall be a part of a healthcare discipline, embrace Anabaptist values, and support the mission of MHF.** Students in professional healthcare study programs are also welcomed.

What Are The Benefits Of Membership? The basic purposes of MHF are carried out through program activities in the categories of service, publications, education and awareness, church connections, and international connections. Activities include:

- Fellowship with other healthcare professionals seeking to integrate Christian faith and practice
- Creative networking within and among healthcare disciplines
- Annual Gathering for inspiration, learning, networking, and relaxation
- Communication via newsletter, journal, and regional meetings
- Opportunities to seek clarity on crucial ethical concerns in healthcare
- Building global church and healthcare relationships
- Supporting significant service projects

Dues and Contributions: There are two levels of membership, Regular (\$85/year) and Sustaining (\$300/year). Students and Retirees may join for \$25/year (\$10/year for undergraduate students). **Anyone who is new to MHF or moving up from a Student rate may join for only \$50 for the first two years.** Mission workers and volunteers may make a voluntary contribution.
